Good to know from Fr. Jude,

Jesus found the church in the hearts of the people: When we say *Jesus found the Church in the hearts of His people*, we are reminded that the Church is not just a building, an institution, or a set of structures. It is first and foremost a **living reality**, born from the love of Christ and made alive by the Holy Spirit dwelling within His followers.

Jesus did not come to build walls of stone, but to **build a community of love** hearts united in faith, hope, and charity. When He called the apostles, healed the sick, forgave sinners, and gathered people around Him, He was already forming the Church, not yet in visible temples, but in the **converted hearts** of those who believed in Him.

The Church truly began when people opened their hearts to Christ's love. It was there, in those hearts, that Jesus found His dwelling place. As Scripture says: "You are God's temple, and God's Spirit dwells in you" (1Corinthians 3.16).

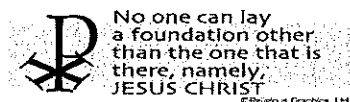
